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Foreword

Education has a critical role to play in children development. It allows a child to acquire knowledge and skills to get developmental opportunities. In addition, greater literacy and basic education help children to understand their needs and demand services. This expands facilities to improve the utilization of these facilities. Education thus empowers the child.

Education is critical for building a modern, market based economy, and raising the living standards. The human capital model in the theories of economic growth shows that a rise in the level of education brings about a corresponding rise in the efficiency of all factors of development. Educated people use capital more efficiently; they think new and better forms of development. They also embrace change and innovation faster and learn new skills.

Literacy is the foundation for building an enlightened, self-reliant society, and a skilled workforce. However, today Rajasthan is ranked at 33 position in terms of literacy among the 35 States and Union Territories in the country. It ranks third from the bottom in illiteracy status of the states of the country. There are considerable disparities between the literacy levels of specific groups such as: rural women, SCs, STs, BCs, minorities, and the rest of the population. Moreover, literacy levels vary greatly between the districts. Rajasthan state literacy rate is 66.1% (male literacy rate is 79.2 % and female literacy rate is 52.1%) as per census 2011. As far as male literacy level is concerned Rajasthan is ranked 27th position and female literacy rank is at 35th position (the last position) in the country, as per the census 2011. Rajasthan State has 1, 91, 45,596 illiterates as per 2011 census. In Rajasthan Udaipur district has 61.82% literacy rate (74.74% males and 48.45% female's literacy rate). Pratapgarh as the second district has 55.95% literacy rate (with 69.5% and 42.35% female's literacy rate).

In both the districts, Udaipur and Pratapgarh. It is a reality that enough schools are not available to children of the state and lack of minimum parental education also contributes to low education literacy. Strength of teachers is not enough classrooms, low teachers attendance also contributed to the low literacy level. Any strategy to raise overall literacy levels will, therefore, have to focus on improving literacy levels among the disadvantaged groups and in the backward regions in the state. In this educational insights and reality, IIFL Foundation prepared State level projects to make all girl children literate and to have an equal opportunity to achieve their full potential. To make the vision a reality, the Gayatri Seva Sansthan is asked to play the implementing partner role. It is responsible for 248 Sakhiyon Ki Baadi's in 248 villages of 164 gram panchayats of two districts of Southern Rajasthan.


The present annual report 2019-2020 depicts the major educational interventions to move towards to make hundred percent children enrolled in school. It is a step towards making every child in the educational institutes.

IIFL Foundation

The IIFL foundation is the Corporate Social Responsibilities arm of IIFL Groups, a financial services conglomerate, started in 2015 to contribute to addressing the most pressing problems faced by India. Be it education programs with illiterate girls in Rajasthan or financial literacy and inclusion of the poor and vulnerable communities in rural West Bengal or work with displaced and affected communities after any natural disaster anywhere in India. It has undertaken long term, high impact projects that create sustainable change and transform the lives of many. The major focus areas of the Foundation include educational programs, financial literacy, disaster relief, preventive health, tribal development, sports development and many more programmes as and when needs/ demands arise. It has formed and developed a program entitled Sakhion Ki Baadi.

Sakhion Ki Baadi (SKB) is a program to address the situation of out of school girls in Rajasthan. The state has the lowest female literacy rate in India (52.1%). In rural hamlets, young girls are found to be 'out of school' owing to numerous reasons ranging from poverty, illiteracy among parents, no access to school, cattle grazing and siblings care or simply the pressure of earning money and contributing to the family's meagre income.

Considering these challenges, it was understood that for these girls to get educated it was needed to reach out to them, right in their villages and more importantly with a customized curriculum to simplify their learning processes. Thus, we initiated - Sakhion Ki Baadi, a community based learning platform for girls in the age group of 4 to 14 years. The SKBs serve as a primary connection to education for girls who dropped out of schools or have never been enrolled in the schools. A learning facilitator - Daksha, especially women, is appointed from the village or the neighbouring one, to run the SKB. The community members are engaged with the SKB's activities, to bring a sustainable change.

While the long-term objective is to change the narrative around girl child education in Rajasthan, the short-term goal is to educate the girls to achieve functional literacy. Learning material is developed in alignment with Rajasthan State board (RBSE) syllabus to conveniently bridge the girls into mainstream education (Govt. Schools) in near future. A number of activities, songs and games are introduced by adopting play-way methods to lure children towards education. Starting in 2016 with 100 Sakhion Ki Baadis and with 3000 girls enrolled in the program, today IIFL Foundation covers 11 districts of Rajasthan with 1164 Sakhion Ki Baadi learning platforms that educate over 35,964 girls towards hundred percent functional literacy.

Gayatri Seva Sansthan

For the present educational interventions, IIFL Foundation has identified Gayatri Seva Sansthan as one of the implementing partners to work with tribal girl children of two districts of Southern Rajasthan keeping in view of rich experience of Gayatri Seva Sansthan.

GSS was established in 1986 with a vision to mainstream tribal children and their families from Southern Rajasthan, to take fruits of on-going developmental interventions by national, state and local governments through empowering them. It has worked in the areas like education, protection of child rights, community mobilisation, livelihood promotion and natural resource management in the Southern part of Rajasthan. Mostly target communities for the interventions were children, parents, farmers, women, youth and tribal communities. Today, GSS's presence is in three states of the country - Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh and Haryana.

GSS believes in working with partners, universities, institutions, government (centre and state), judiciary, media etc. It is proud to have worked with NABARD, CAPART, UNICEF, World Bank, IIFL Foundation, IIMPACT, Development Alternatives, Vedanta, Kailash Satyarthi Children's Foundation India, ICICI Foundation and other international agencies.

GSS has developed Shikshalaya as a unique educational model from its inception.

The organisation has received many honours at state and national levels for its outstanding contributions in the field of girl child education and enrolment. Recently, GSS was recognised by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs and Development, Government of Rajasthan on International Day for World Indigenous People. With vast experience of GSS it has created and developed three major areas to facilitate its work.

GSS's field of expertise are:

1. *Human and Institutional Development*
2. *Livelihood Enhancement*
3. *Natural Resources Management*

Child Rights has been this organisation's forte. It is providing 9099 children through 304 free education platforms with 304 Dakshas/resource teachers who are responsible for making education lively and interesting to sustain and mainstream the children. The achievements of the organizations are as follows:

1. Mainstreamed 5787 out of school children with government institutions
2. Enrolled 9099 tribal girl child
3. Running 304 free education platforms
4. Formed and oriented five block level child protection Committees.
5. Constructed 210 Panchayat Level Child Protection Committees are active and visible
6. Institutionalized coordination between various committees at Gram Panchayat and Panchayat Samiti level.
7. Facilitated benefits to 5483 vulnerable children/ families
8. Formed 88 School Management Committees
9. School development plans 88 were prepared in consultation with teachers and parents
10. Around 43,053 persons covered through various awareness campaigns on impacts of child labour, importance and role of child education etc.
11. First time in history of Udaipur Division 51 special child friendly Gram Sabhas were organized by the Panchayati Raj Institutions.
12. Information Education and Communication materials on Social Security Schemes, Panchayat Level Child Protection Committees, School Management Committee, Child Helpline and Child Protection have been developed in the local language for Panchayat Raj Institutions.
13. The module named "*Buniyaad*" has been developed for the effective orientation of Panchayati Level Child Protection Committees which became a great tool to conduct five effective training of Panchayati Level Child Protection Committees to make them functional. (That time this was the first module in the entire state for effective training of Gram Panchayat Level Child Protection Committees).

GSS is fortunate to be associated with the Girl Child Education Programme 'Sakhion Ki Baadi'. With above described rich experiences of GSS, it has received the Girl Child Education Programme from IIFL Foundation, Mumbai with Sakhion Ki Baadi is the major input in the present programme. The details about Sakhion Ki Baadi follows in the next pages.






Sakhियों Ki Baadi

India is home to millions of out of school children and the worst affected, who either drop out of school early in their life or are never enrolled due to cultural, economic or geographic problems. IIFL Foundation has made it its mission to change the destinies of young children especially girls through an educational programme known as Sakhion ki Baadi.

Sakhion Ki Baadi (SKB) is an initiative by IIFL Foundation to address the situation of out of school girls in Rajasthan, the state having the lowest female literacy rate in India. In rural hamlets of Rajasthan, young girls are found to be 'out of school' owing to numerous reasons ranging from poverty, illiteracy among parents, no access to school, cattle and sibling care or simply the pressure of earning money and contributing to family's income. Considering these challenges, it was understood that for these girls to get educated, there is a need to reach out to them, right in their villages and more importantly with a customized curriculum to simplify their learning process. Thus, IIFL Foundation initiated

Sakhion ki Baadi, a community based learning platform for girls in the age group of 4 to 14 years serves as a primary connection to education for girls that have dropped out of schools or have never been enrolled or irregular. A learning facilitator - Daksha, especially a woman is appointed from the village or the neighbouring one, to run the SKBs. The community members are engaged with the SKBs activities, to bring a sustainable change. While the long-term objective is to change the narrative around girl child education, the short-term goal is to educate the girls to achieve functional literacy.

SKB is a unique program that works at creating excitement among the girls regarding education and keeps them motivated to shift education as an important priority in their life. The name Sakhiyon ki baadi has been very carefully chosen with no reference to education, studies or school as the program is based on play way method of learning and we believe that given the challenges they face and given the other tasks they need to perform at home; education can only happen subtly and through fun based activities as this can be the only way to keep them motivated. Sakhiyon Ki Baadi transforming the tribal girls and the major inputs:

1. Ease of access to the enrolled girls
2. Comfortable seating place, colorful and exciting class ambience
3. Well defined and designed curriculum with theme based learning and story sessions
4. Localized content with a lot of scope for teachers to be creative
5. Well defined competency tests to track each girl separately and
6. allow her to learn at her own pace
7. Identification of slow learners/learning disability etc and providing remedial support to such girls
8. Focus on teachers training and professional development
9. Focus on simultaneously acquiring key skills: speaking, listening, reading, writing and thinking
10. Theme based learning and story sessions integrated into curriculum
11. Encouraging girls to ask questions with a question hour blended into the program
12. School leadership development by dividing girls into houses and conducting house based competitions and events "Giving back to the community" is an important element of the program with events designed and defined to achieve this
13. Involvement of community leaders in SKB operations.
14. Entrenched accountability mechanism including code of conduct for school governance
15. Support to teachers at various levels to achieve the objectives

Roots of the Program

Children are an asset to society. It is the responsibility of the society to nurture them through various phases of their development, to enable children to make a meaningful contribution. And yet the phenomenon of millions of children working for a pittance across the globe is a grim reminder of the failure of the society as well as international institutes to protect and to nurture its greatest asset and to tackle one of the most serious anomalies of modern development in the world.

Few abuses of Human Rights are so universally condemned, but at the same time so universally practiced such as those of the child labourers. By any objective measure this issue should rank high on the global agenda, but in practice, it is surrounded by a wall of silence and perpetuated by ignorance. Child labour continues to be an affront to the conscience of the world community. Today, we have an opportunity and a duty to bring this evil practice to an end. The present project is in a right direction to fulfil international and national commitments towards Child Rights.



EnVision a Dream

There are international conventions on child rights, Indian constitution, committees and commissions constituted from time to time, National policies on education and child labour, various national and state level programmes on children have failed to address hundred percent enrolment of children in education and also providing free and compulsory education to children between six to fourteen years as per constitution of India. To meet constitutional and other commitments various programmes were implemented to address the constitutional rights of the children of India to achieve constitutional commitments, at micro level, IIFL Foundation came forward to support Rajasthan government to put every girl child into school and to have equal opportunities to children to achieve full potential. It identified Gayatri Seva Sansthan, which has been working among tribal children of Southern Rajasthan since the last 34 years and has been making significant contributions. IIFL Foundation has been working in Udaipur, Pratapgarh, Bhilwara, Jalor, Ajmer, Banswara, Jodhpur, Pali, Sirohi, Abu Road, to cover 1164 SKBs reaching to 35,964 girls to contribute towards vision of hundred percent literacy. GSS was given 248 SKBs to cover 7414 girls in Udaipur and Pratapgarh Districts of Southern Rajasthan. The present report details initiatives towards making tribal girls literate. It begins with a brief on IIFL Foundation.

Enrolment of Children at Sakhiyon Ki Baadi

(2019-2020)

The coverage of villages under the five blocks is 248 villages reaching out around 1,48,766 populations of the programme. To achieve hundred percent literacy as a vision of the present programme, two baseline surveys were conducted under this programme - one in year 2018 and then in the year 2019, for enrolment of children in 248 SKBs. It was found in the 2019 survey that 2572(34.69%) dropouts and 2070 (27.92%) irregular children. It is also heartening to report that 2772 (37.38%) children were never enrolled in any academic institutions even after 73 years of India's freedom. It reflects lack of priority of education and literacy as an agenda of the country.

Dr. D.S. Kothari committee in 1967 recommended that 10 percent of the GDP should be spent on education. Till today, India's government has still to spend even up to 5 percent of the GDP. Roots of the lack of literacy is the low percentage of investment in education. Most of the educational budget goes to higher education and gets less priority after secondary and higher and technical education.

It is sad to report that from the present education system significant children were dropout and irregular (See Table 03). It reflects that there is a need of platforms like ours and the need to put more effort into the present system of education as far as quality of education, attendance of the teachers, educational aid, teaching methodologies, teacher parent relationship etc. These educational systems are meant to be child friendly, child centrally and child focused. Their focus deviates from time to time with government directions and directives. Rest of the above perspective and attitude on education, children left out as never enrolled, dropout, irregular and also migrate with families and relatives to far and far places for gains. They became bonded child labour (called as Haali's in local language), trafficked, child prostitute, get married at an early age (child marriage), sold is a present phenomenon in the tribal belt of Southern Rajasthan. When it comes to Southern Rajasthan, the situation becomes even worse and pathetic, especially in Banswara, Pratapgarh, Dungarpur, Sirohi and Udaipur districts of Rajasthan.

In the above backdrop IIFL foundation came forward and took the challenge to make Rajasthan State hundred percent literate among the child population between 4 to 14 years of age. To meet the 21 (A) constitutional commitment of the country in a long way.

IIFL Foundation started a literacy program in 2016. At present it is covering 11 districts of Rajasthan, 1164 SKB with total enrolment of 35,964 girls. Gayatri Seva Sansthan is partner while taking the responsibility of running 248 SKBs enrolling 7414 children, the 20.61 percent of the total children enrolled with IIFL Foundations total SKBs. It is a very substantial and major programme of IIFL Foundation.

Out of 7414 children enrolled by GSS, 5530 are girls (74.58%) and 1184 are boys (15.96%). Gayatri Seva Sansthan has reached to 2772 new families whose children were never enrolled in schools. Credit goes to the IIFL Foundation for making it happen to open the educational doors to around 6242 destitute tribal families of Udaipur and Pratapgarh districts of Rajasthan. The cluster wise and SKB wise enrolments are attached will reflect in depth enrolment of children of the programme which will give future enrolment of SKBs children.

Presence of Children in SKBs

Attendance in one of the indicators of the presence of children in SKBs. During the 2019-2020 period all SKBs (248) were opened for 298 days (See Table-04). Attendance reflects willingness of tribal children of southern Rajasthan to be in SKBs. It was possible because of taking SKBs nearer to their Helmet. Some of the tribal community constructed of SKBs Jhopda (place where child seats, read, write, play) these SKBs have become Children homes. There are some children, mother and community at large.

Selecting Dakshas from some helmets or nearly helmets played a vital role in children attending SKBs. It also led in accepting and developing ownership of SKBs by the local community which makes children's interest in learning and playing. Employing the Dakshas from some places also facilitated in follow ups with parents, Sicomm meetings and then education all, social, cultural and spiritual initiatives of SKBs and around SKBs.

Attendance is a very crucial Indicator of implementing a program to fund by funding organisation. It indicates child interest and attitude towards education. There were children in some SKBs who were present all working days (Hundred percent) . They also come on Vacations and have quality time at SKBs.

Program needs to develop strategies to continue to retain the interest of these highly motivated SKBs children. Out of these children most of them went to regular government schools. The Sakhiyon Ki Baadi program had mainstreamed 1179 children which included the child's attendance. Keeping positivity among interested and regular children became a challenge to implementing and funding organisations to continue with new and creative strategies.

Data of children on attendance shows that some children were slow as well as attended SKBs less number of days (See Table-05). The real challenge had been faced by the program. These were several excuses made by the SKBs children as well as their parents for not sending children to SKBs.

Some Daksha and cluster heads have faced some tough times to convince children's parents to daily send their child at SKBs. children absence from SKBs tells implementing agencies and capabilities of Dakshas, cluster heads, block heads, program management at headquarter. Present trainings were not enough to this issue to motivate children of SKBs. The attendance at clusters and block wise were also documented for developing insights for further interventions by Dakshas cluster heads and block heads for further initiatives.

Empowering the Programme through Training Interventions

Dakshas Capacity Building Initiatives

It is heartening to record that this project has inbuilt daksha's training - continuously and periodically, to develop their personal and professional skills. These training demonstrates how to do, what to do, when to do, and how much to do with a practical approach visible in all 25 dakshas training during the current financial year. Table-06 shows details of Daksha's block-wise training with dates and number of trainees. A total of 1350 dakshas took training to develop their capacities as a leader of SKB to influence children's education. These Dakshas are chosen with care and sensitivity keeping in view their acceptability in community as well as children. It was noticed that after the training Dakshas are more clear about their inputs in Sakhiyon Ki Baadis. Confidence level of these Dakshas were enhanced and they were able to speak. Some of them were pleasant to put their inquiries during training sessions which reflects their curiosity to perform. In these training one more skill enhanced was how to influence children as well as the community during their job. During training pre-test and post-test were held to reflect on the changes in learning and grasping of inputs of training. These tests reflect learning assessments and mental records. Better teaching methods were also reflected through various inputs by different facilitators/ resource persons. These training interventions of Dakshas also gave them insights about their strengths and behaviour to overcome weaknesses. Feedback became a tool to reflect their own involvement and acquiring skills. SKBs interactions as well as teaching classroom interactions also gave them a positive kick to enhance the education/ teaching environment at their respective SKBs. Classroom management lesson planning, how to begin the session, how to address the children's questions and observations of teachers' behaviour were also part of the training to improve Dakshas capabilities. They participated and invested in these training and at the same time they took risks to ask questions and contributed in their development faster than others. Training also reflected their proactiveness, work ethics reporting time, communication pattern, feedback skills. A significant change is visible after these training sessions. The objectives of the trainings were:

1. Helped Dakshas on children evaluation processes
2. Dakshas assessment during and after training
3. Classroom assessment
4. Peers feedback
5. Resource persons feedback and analysing
6. Identifying weak teachers and strong teachers.

Daksha's Tool

Curriculum development became a part of Daksha's training which was organised every three months under the supervision of the programme management team. Prior to training the syllabus of the training was designed by IIFL professionals in consultations with GSS and other resources persons. It is developed keeping in mind the requirements of the children keeping quality of education. Activities were also developed and given to the teachers during training led to enhanced confidence and self-development. The approach and focus finalized were as follows:

- 1.Using principles of children literacy
- 2.Other module of the organisation
- 3.Own experience-
- 4.ASER tool

The focus in on Daksha's cultural identity and her current knowledge:

- 1.Offer windows for new knowledge
- 2.Support search for a positive self-image
- 3.The general aim is ownership of choices
- 4.The goal is well being

To sum, all the training has contributed to Daksha's personal and teaching development. These interventions will go a long way in making Daksha's life more meaningful and constructive, beyond the present programme.

Daksha: Community Change leaders

Under the Sakhiyon Ki Baadi programme, local educated women are given the priority in the role of Daksha. This is an integral part that ensures gender empowerment. Many of our female Daksha are the first working women in their homes and families. And among them some are the first working women in the whole village. Ms. Maangi Kumari Meena at SKB Maayda and Ms. Prema Kumari at SKB Achal Puriya, Pipalkhunt, Pratapgarh are two such exemplary women who have made the odds as an opportunity not just for themselves but for the whole village. This is an achievement of the programme that has empowered 150 females with opportunities for socio economic development and competency building.

Ms Maangi Kumari is managing 36 children at her SKB and understands all her responsibility as Daksha. She inspires her community women to prioritise education for girls.

Ms Prema Kumari was always inclined towards education and learning. She understands the importance of continuous learning as her school was hampered because of family responsibilities as a daughter, sister, later on as a wife and mother. Reading about the recruitment under Sakhiyon Ki Baadi, Ms. Prema Kumari was encouraged to take the initiative and join the programme as a resource teacher. Today she has become a motivator for the village women and girls - Education is the only way to social uplift.

Training of Trainers to Implementing Partners

Training of Trainers is a special feature of the programme in which synergy was developed among the implementing partners from 11 districts of Rajasthan out of which six programmes were directly monitored and implemented by IIFL Foundation, rest four are implemented mentioned in the table 26.

Two training sessions were organised covering 117 trainers from all implementing partners to IIFL Foundation. The objectives were to develop a common strategy of the programme, sharing experiences of each partner, challenges faced in achieving results, sharing special features of partners, expectations of IIFL Foundation, and challenges to meet vision of the present programme. These TOT training had a long term impact on developing resource persons of the SKB programme. TOTs are a long term investment in capacity building of project partners. Details annexed in the end. Dakshas Meeting with Cluster Head

This is the first ground level collective process in the form of a monthly sitting with the Dakshas who are the key to the success of the programme. This is the platform where Dakshas first experience is to be shared, recorded and feedback taken and given encouragement to Dakshas, also took place at this juncture. It also helps in identifying limitations of different SKBs and to receive the need for improvement of SKBs, SKBs planning for the forthcoming months also take place. At this platform TLM creation, topics of teaching importance, issues of children and parents, performance of SICOM. These meetings have proven to be remedial classes to eliminate the points of confusions and errors also. Cluster heads are responsible for overall supervision, monitoring and management of the 12 /or 13 SKBs grouped under its cluster. Best performing SKB is chosen as the place of the meetings in order to inculcate the best practices and encouragement by building the competencies. The overall objectives of this meeting is to translate the Dakshas retention strategy, TLM making, feedback on home visits and improvising the SKBs by group participations. Unique Inputs During the Implementation of the Programme

Google Spreadsheets

Internet based utility applications with vast features such as Google Spreadsheets are used by GSS professionals to maintain a real time tracking of programme activities. These are accessible by GSS professionals at headquarters for daily, weekly and monthly feedback assessment. The sheet uses the objective based approach and maintains the database. Inclusion of the approach has contributed efficiency in HRM from the cluster to district level and monitored feedback of working hours at all levels in the hierarchy of the programme. Thus it has maximised the programme output. The usage of novel technologies have raised the technical knowledge of cluster heads and block heads, increasing their confidence towards Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) based solutions to the rising challenges at field level.

Celebrating Children's Week

Children are the future fathers of the world. Nurturing them with participatory developmental activities is the prime objective of the Sakhiyon Ki Baadi programme. Girls in tribal particularly need to be encouraged to embrace the development opportunities and create ownership to their rights of

1. *Right to live*
2. *Right to safety*
3. *Rights to development*
4. *Right to equal opportunities*

In the process Gayatri Seva Sansthan organised a whole One week celebration of Children's Day from November 14 to November 20 in 2019. The activities were designed to ensure participation of girls, their parents, and members of PRIs of the village. The activities rigored the emotions of the child and built a platform for parents and community at large to the importance of children in family as well as beyond families.

Sensitivity towards Children Health *Doctors-on-Wheels*

Health and nutrition are often the neglected aspect in India especially in the tribal belts. Children, especially in tribal villages, are often assumed to be well nourished. And this is a common myth among parents in rural families but it is otherwise. Gayatri Seva Sansthan felt the need to develop a primary health database of the children at SKBs in exclusive and community at large. Therefore in the year 2019, GSS initiated Primary Healthcare Services Camps through Doctors-On-Wheels initiative in three blocks. These blocks were identified on suitability of our healthcare team and desire. Doctors-on-Wheels Healthcare Service consisted of three doctors - Child Specialist, ENT Specialist, and General Physician, instruments for basic mapping, OTC medicines support for community members.

Under all the health initiative during the year 2019-2020, we reached a total number of 37,200 of persons from the community along with Primary Health Screening of 7440 Children of the three blocks.

Keeping the Children's health in mind another initiative in the year 2019 was providing all of the SKB children with Iron fortified edible supplements. And so Chocolate flavoured Iron fortified cookies sponsored by Britannia Nutrition Foundation. Children were delighted to receive them and increased their participation in SKBs. (See the Table-13) Britannia Nutrition Foundation came forward to address and improve the health and well-being of vulnerable children in Sakhiyon Ki Baadis. In the process of addressing the present nutrition needs of Sakhiyon Ki Baadi children Britannia Nutrition Foundation exclusive Iron fortified cookies were facilitated. Each cookie provided 5mgs of elemental Iron as recommended under RDA. Following were daily dosage guidelines:

- 1.4 to 6 years old Child: One Cookie per day
- 2.6 to 10 years old child: Two Cookies per day
- 3.10 years and above child: Three Cookies per day

Britannia Nutrition Foundation supported us with 27000 cookies. A total of 3000 packets constituting 9 Cookies were distributed. These cookies were exclusively made to be consumed in one month. This initiative increased the enthusiasm of children and participation in SKB. The details on cookies distribution is shown in the table above.

Gayatri Seva Sansthan is glad to share that throughout the years we identify such villages /or hamlets and initiate the celebration of the days of national importance.

2019 Republic day was celebrated on all of the SKBs and sweets were distributed among children. Dagaliya Fala in Kharaka Cluster in Salumber block is a remote hamlet. The hamlet and the PRIs offices are not in easy communication reach and thus the villagers have never got the opportunity to witness flag hosting and emotion of patriotism. On GSS's initiative flag hoisting ceremony was organised at SKB Dangaliya Fala. The senior most elder Shri Kesulal Meena, hoisted the flag and the National Anthem was sung by SKB children and Team. The community members felt proud and women equally participated to celebrate patriotism.

And these initiatives must be inculcated at a young age for them to acquire the knowledge and understanding of the importance of living in a democracy. Gayatri Seva Sansthan conducted a Children's Rally in Sarada Block on Education for Democracy. These rallies were organised in all the four clusters. Women and mothers took part seeing the enthusiasm of children. The community members were made aware of the rights of children and importance of education for girls and protection against child marriage and child labour. The block team also shared the knowledge on election, votings and importance of voting the right candidate for the development of the children and community at large.

Environmental Responsibility



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Farmers are always the closest to nature and often the most sensitive towards the importance of natural resources offered by mother Earth. In the Pipalkhunt block, Gayatri Seva Sansthan initiated a plantation and restoration campaign. In the process, the block head Shri Bherulal Bhat led the whole campaign. Two plants were planted at every SKB and a total of one hundred plants. The respective DAKSHAs were made responsible to make tree guards and their growth. 700 chopal members participated in awareness generation. Gayatri Seva Sansthan is sincerely grateful to District Magistrate Mr. Shyam Singh Rajpurohit and also to Mr. Sangram Singh Katiyaar, Assistant Forest Officer, Forest Department - Pratapgarh for providing their support and guidance

Educational Fostering of a Visioned Girl

When the community categorises facilities it may debarr some specially abled - be it in public or even among families. So was the story of Laxmi - a visioned child.

Laxmi is blind by birth. Since she was born to a marginal family with 4 other children to look after too, Laxmi was never encouraged to her potential. Parents parted because of incompatibility and Laxmi was among the worst hit by this when she was bound to domestic chores.

Laxmi can recite poems in hindi and english, and perform basic mathematical operations. She don't hesitate to speak about herself and is a source of inspiration in her village.

Community Ownership Towards Education

Pipalkhant is one of the most vast block under the SKB programme, in terms of area. The block is surrounded by dense forest and literacy levels are the least in Rajasthan. Under the programme Jaliya Hamlet was identified to have more than 30 out of school/ drop out or irregular girl children. Thus following all the steps, it was decided to initiate a SKB in Jaliya hamlet. Challenge was the non availability of suitable places to initiate the study. When the block representative raised the issue with the community and enthusiastic community decided to build an actual Baadi. All the families contributed with wood logs, labour and made a sheltered structure for SKB. The average enrollment for the SKB has been 31 for the past three years and Daksha Mr. Kesulala Meena takes immense pride in his children and the SICOM. This contribution by the community is evident to the ownership and dedication of community members towards IIFL Foundation SKB programme.

School Chalein Hum Abhiyaan

(Lets Go School)



Sakhiyon Ki Baadi programme is aimed to empower the out of school girl child with functional literacy and later on mainstream her with government educational institutions. The Lets Go Schools Campaign was initiated by Gayatri Seva Sansthan in the months of May and June, 2019. During the months of May and June government schools give admission to children and exclusive drives are organised at village level. In the process to achieve the Mission 2020 targets and successfully streamline these out of school children with government schools.

Community Empowerment through Chopal Meetings

Empowering through Chopal Meetings

Community involvement is also an important and integral part of the Sakhiyon Ki Baadi programme. Community empowerment is more than the involvement, participation and engagement of communities. It implies community ownership and action that explicitly aims at social and political change. Community empowerment is a process of re-negotiating power in order to gain more control. It recognizes that if some people are going to be empowered then others will be sharing their existing power and giving some of it up. Empower is a central concept in community development and invariably operates within the arena of a power struggle. Chopal Meetings play a crucial role in strengthening SKBs and the place to receive feedback on children of SKBs and other interventions ongoing along the programme. It plays a really vital role in breezing between communities and SKBs. Chopal has become a vehicle for strengthening the programme's vision for enroll in achieving hundred percent literacy. During this financial year 38,053 community members attended monthly chopals at every SKBs. Chotisadari block has covered the highest numbers of persons from the community in chopal meetings. Sarada block reached out to 5,655 persons through chopal meetings (See Table-14). There is a need to cover more persons from the communities for achieving a higher level of commitment of community towards SKBs and the programme as well.

Raatri Chopal

The case Study on innovation to involve the whole community

Working parents are often unable to attend the educational development of their children reported by teachers. In villages also, parents often go to wage earning activities like farming and labour therefore cannot attend the SICOM regularly. And this was hampering in convergence of our larger objectives of participation by community. To address the challenge Gayatri Seva Sansthan initiated a Raatri Chopal with community members in Salumber block. The impact was visible when the community participated in the Samvaad Activities. The program was started with as usual schedule of our SKB's Prayer and Group Song by students of our SKB's all villagers are join us in the Prayer , after that we welcomed our event Chief Guest Mr. Kalu Ram Jibhil - Sarpanch of Badi Village and Mr. Takhatmalji -Former Sarpanch of Village by Siccom member of our respective SKB's and respected community members. A total of 450 tribal persons participated from three villages of the Salumber Block.

Mainstreaming of Sakhiyon Ki Baadi Students with Formal Educational Institutions

Mainstreaming in the context of education is the practice of placing children with quality education services in a general education classroom during specific time periods based on their skills and learning. To be more specific, this means children who are a part of the quality education classroom will join the regular education classroom at certain times which are fitting for the regular education child.

Mainstreaming has been a key component and an integral part of the IIFL Foundation's girl child education programme. In the year 2018-2019, the GSS has mainstreamed 637 children to government schools and Maa-Badis. And in the year 2019-2020, GSS has mainstreamed 1179 SKBs and other village children in regular schools.

The processes involved in mainstreaming of Sakhiyon ki Baadis children are:

- Did a baseline survey of the village to identify never enrolled, drop out or irregular children
- Made a list of 30 and above out of school children as mentioned above between 5 to 14 years age
- Had meeting with villagers to develop collective decision to open SKB
- Identify place of SKB in consultation with community
- Identification and selections of Dakshas in consultation with villagers, cluster head, block head and final decision taken in consultation with project manager
- Availability of teaching aide at SKB
- Continuous training to Dakshas
- Acquiring various educational levels
- Achieving level 6
- Preparing children for test to be taken in government institutions
- Informed and share the achievements of the child for their completing academic achievements to their parents
- Taking decisions in consultation with child's parents to enrol the child in government and other institutions
- Preparing the child for the environment - Dos & Don'ts of government institutions needed for continue education
- Identifying the child based on its learning level and aptitude to fit into peers at classroom

- Child after achieving level 6 is suitable to be mainstreamed in school
- Generated a demand of school/ Maa Badi for putting children into government institutions
- Demand was put to concerned department to open schools and influenced to open the school where school was not available
- Visiting the government institutions with parents to enrol the child
- Taking certificate of enrolment of the child from the head of the institution as a record for further communications with the child enrolled
- Time to time visit of Dakshas /or cluster head to observe and resolving any issue emerged in the process of child learning
- Institutionalise support system to mainstream children
- Continuous dialogue and repo with the mainstream child, parents and teachers
- These mainstreamed children become ambassadors of the SKBs
- Ownership of community and mainstreamed children enhanced
- Running of SKBs by community visualized and brought to reality
- Open the door of hundred percent literacy in villages and surrounding areas
- These small step are connected to vision of making every child literate

During the current financial year 2019-2020, GSS has mainstreamed 1179 children (Table 15).

Mainstreaming of the children of SKBs into government schools has been the programmes key parameters. Last year, 2018-2019, the GSS has mainstreamed 665 children from all the six blocks of the programme. (See Table-16.01, Table-16.02 and Annexure 16 for more details). This year the GSS has mainstreamed 1179 children which come to 15.9 percent of the total children enrolled with the programme. The change in number of children mainstreamed is 77.29 percent. The Sarada block has mainstreamed the highest number of children mainstreamed which is highest among all the blocks. Then it is followed by Salumber, Lasadiya, Pipalkhunt, Chotti Sadari and then Girwa.

Mainstreaming the Sakhyion ki Baadi with Government Institutions

The vision of the programme is to reach hundred percent literacy among children below the 14 years of age. To achieve the vision of IIFL Foundation the GSS had mainstreamed 14 Sakhyion ki Baadis into Maa Badi. Today 420 of children had been benefitting with government facilities under the Maa Baadi Scheme. This year GSS has mainstreamed 8 more SKBs into Maa Baadis. Children from Salumber (SKBs of Vida Fala, and Raghunathpura in cluster Ganvdapal), Lasadiya (SKB - Ghoga Fala, Mataji Fala in Cluster Manpuriya and SKB Kachra in Cluster Aggad), and Chotti Sadari (SKBs - Karanpur, Hari Singh ji ka kheda, Kankra in cluster Satola) cover 230 SKB Children. after mainstreaming, GSS has started new SKBs in the same Clusters and covering 230 new dropout, never enrolled, and irregular children of the programme area. GSS has been following up the mainstreamed children and the progress made by them. The table below providing the details about the SKBs mainstreamed into Maa Baadis in the year 2019-2020.

It is sad to report that four children are no more and died during the year. Details are shown in the table 56 regarding migrations of Children from Sakhiyon Ki Baadi. 22 children of the SKBs of Lasadiya, Pipalkhunt Salumber and Sarada have left the SKBs due to their family migration from the villages. They went along with their families. There is need to develop a mechanism for tracing migrant children and also to take responsibility to put them in school where they have left.

A documentation of each and every developmental initiative should be recorded and documented time to time, during implementation of the project. GSS dream is to make the area child labour free at the same time hundred percent enrolment of children below 18 years of age as per Child Labour Act and JJ Act.
